Park Department by-laws established for the governance of food vendors:

- 1. Food vendors must be in compliance with all Vigo County Board of Health regulations.
- 2. Food vendors must abide by the following:
 - a. Keep your space and bordering area clean.
 - b. If a set up time is provided, arrive at that time.
 - c. Open and close daily at the specified times and remain open on the last day until the closing time provided.
 - d. You must operate your concession for the entire 10 days, unless you have been granted an exception by the park department.
- 3. Do not advertise or attempt to sell any items that are not included in your contract with the Terre Haute Parks and Recreation Department.
- 4. Maintain a <u>mandatory</u> minimum of 5 feet of space between you and the adjacent vendor so as not to confuse the customer during busy hours.
- 5. A food vendor, and/or his immediate family, may occupy up to 2 food spaces. The second space will be considered upon a space available basis according to the above by-laws for selection of food vendors.
- 6. Food vendors that occupy a second space must serve exactly the same menu as in the original space. When a food vendor has 2 spaces, he still has only 2 protected items.
- 7. Food vendors that remain in good standing with the Terre Haute Parks and Recreation Department will be asked to return the following year.
- 8. The company that provides the carnival rides has by contract reserved some exclusive food items for their use only.
